

Parent Volunteer Opportunities

How Parents can help:

- 1. <u>Nominations Committee</u>- Parents would meet monthly to help find qualified candidates for the Board- *10 Volunteer spots*
- 2. <u>Academic Committee</u>- Parents would meet regularly with Headmaster to discuss and assess best practices for the school- *5 Volunteer spots*
- 3. <u>Property Committee</u>- Parents would meet regularly to plan for future property (and vehicle) needs and address any immediate building/vehicle issues- 5 *Volunteer spots*
- 4. **Fundraising Committee** Parents would manage and plan fundraising events for the school- *10 Volunteer spots*
- 5. <u>Parent Action Committee (PAC)</u>- All families are part of this committee and one leadership role will be chosen among families. Parents would meet regularly to plan and execute:
 - a. Family events
 - b. Awards Banquet
 - c. Prom
 - d. Graduation

- 6. <u>Chaperoning</u>- Parents would choose 1 excursion and pay their own way. <u>We need</u>

 3 Parent Chaperones for each trip.
 - a. Fall- Calvin Center and 10-12th Grade trip
 - b. Winter- Jekyll Island and 10-12th Grade trip
 - c. Spring- 9-10th Grade trip and 11-12th Grade trip
- 7. <u>School Uniform Shop</u>- As we receive used Uniforms, parents would organize and 2x a year resell them to other families who need them.- *3 Volunteer spots*
- 8. School Lunch Pickup- Each Wednesday the school offers the students an opportunity to order outside lunch from a few select restaurants on rotation.
 Parents would rotate each week going out and picking up the orders. 2 Volunteer spots
- 9. Student Council Leader- 1 Volunteer spot
- 10. Beta Club Leader 1 Volunteer spot
- 11. Interact Club Leader (Freshman class) 1 Volunteer spot
- **12.** <u>Shopper-</u> Parents would check in weekly to see if there were any supplies that needed to be bought and picked up for the school (i.e. copy paper, cleaning supplies, etc.)- *2 Volunteer spots*
