We are currently seeking a highly motivated and creative Spanish teacher for our Lower School program who is passionate about developing an immersive language classroom. The successful candidate will be responsible for delivering high-quality instruction that inspires and challenges students to achieve their full potential in the Spanish language. They will be expected to utilize a variety of techniques to create an immersive environment where students are encouraged to communicate in Spanish and develop their language skills.

Central Responsibilities:

- Plan, prepare and deliver engaging Spanish lessons that promote immersion and the natural use of language in real-world situations.
- Use authentic materials, such as news articles, songs, and videos, to teach language and culture.
- Incorporate conversational practice into lessons to help students develop their communication skills and confidence in using the language.
- Utilize project-based learning to help students apply their language skills to real-world situations, such as creating a cultural fair, interviewing native Spanish speakers, or creating a Spanish-language play.
- Assess student progress, providing regular feedback to students and parents.
- Upload assignments and grades into the school information system.
